Dear Parent Carer

The past few weeks has been a difficult time for many and continues to bring up challenges. As you may be aware, the government made announcements earlier this week closing secondary schools across the country. This followed with an announcement that all schools in London will close including primary schools.

Despite the rise in the number of cases, the government has chosen to keep primary schools open, other than in London. However, we have seen a number of cases where schools in Birmingham have chosen to remain closed for now, except for children of key workers and from vulnerable groups.

Whatever the case, we are expecting that there may be changes to the government's decision and if not, we will surely see more children self-isolating as a result of contracting the virus themselves, or due to coming into close contact with someone who has contracted the virus.

For this reason, we are taking steps to rearrange our teaching and planning to ensure we can cater for all eventualities. As a result, we will be delaying re-opening by a day giving us time to make the necessary preparations and amendments. School will therefore **open to pupils on Wednesday 6th January 2021** and not Tuesday.
