Jeans for Genes Day

Jeans for Genes Day is an annual fundraising campaign which is aimed at supporting families and individuals affected by genetic disorders. The campaign raises money through a variety of activities to provide grants to organisations which transform the lives of children living with genetic disorders. Schools who wish to partake in the fundraising event, encourage children and staff to wear jeans and other casual wear to school rather than their traditional uniforms on specific days.

Al Ameen Primary School will be taking part in this year's Jeans for Genes Day on **Friday 20th September 2024**.

1 in 25 children has a genetic disorder that makes their life very difficult. That's like one in every class. We are asking all children to wear an item of denim clothing on the day and **bring in a contribution of £1** which will go towards the charity, Jeans for Genes. The item of clothing could be a jacket, a shirt, trousers, etc. Children do not need to come in school uniform on the day if they are wearing denim clothing.

Jeans for Genes have a series of powerful films to explain how donations will make a difference. Each film provides a compelling and personal insight, introducing some amazing children living with genetic disorders, sharing first-hand what life is like with their condition.
